Professions: A variety of health professions

Grade Level: 3-5

All HOTT lesson plans are designed with the purpose of increasing students' awareness of the variety of health careers that are available to them. If possible, invite the corresponding health professional into your classroom to discuss his/her occupation. If this is not an option, use the attached sheet(s) to share this/these career(s) with your students.

Purpose: Students will learn more about different medical professions by researching and dressing up as specific health career and then by viewing other presentations.

Materials needed: Computer with internet access, library, and creativity!

Duration: 1 week

Instructions:

- Students should research a specific medical profession (see list).
- After researching, students should answer the following questions:
 - 1. What do they do?
 - 2. What kind of equipment do they use?
 - 3. Where do they work?
- After answering these questions the student should construct a "costume" representing the profession they are reporting on.
- On presentation day, the students should present their mini-reports while wearing their costumes.
- Remind the students how many different professions exist and try to stress how important each profession is.
