

Healthcare Professions Bookmarks/Brochures

Professions: A variety of health professions

Grade Level: 6-12

All HOTT lesson plans are designed with the purpose of increasing students' awareness of the variety of health careers that are available to them. If possible, invite the corresponding health professional into your classroom to discuss his/her occupation. If this is not an option, use the attached sheet(s) to share this/these career(s) with your students.

Purpose: To use research and creativity to create a bookmark/brochure to educate elementary students on the various healthcare professions.

Materials needed: Internet, library, computer access, paper, and printer

Duration: 2 - 3 class periods

Instructions:

- Students will make bookmarks/brochures outlining a health profession.
- The bookmarks should be made on the computer.
- Remember, the students who will be using these bookmarks/brochures are elementary students, so make sure everything is appropriate; i.e. word usage, graphic choices, etc.
- Students should be allowed time to research the career they are assigned or have chosen; assigning will avoid duplication of careers.
- After a period of researching, students should be allowed time to input the information into a fun and creative bookmark/brochure for the elementary students. Keep the bookmarks fun and interesting so that the younger students learn too!
