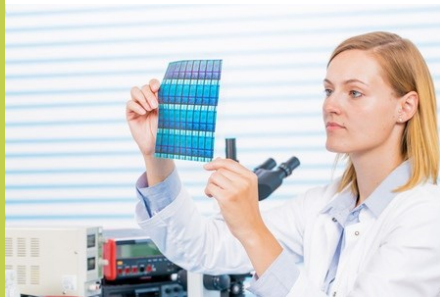

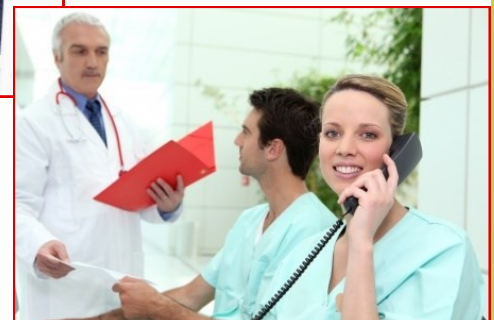

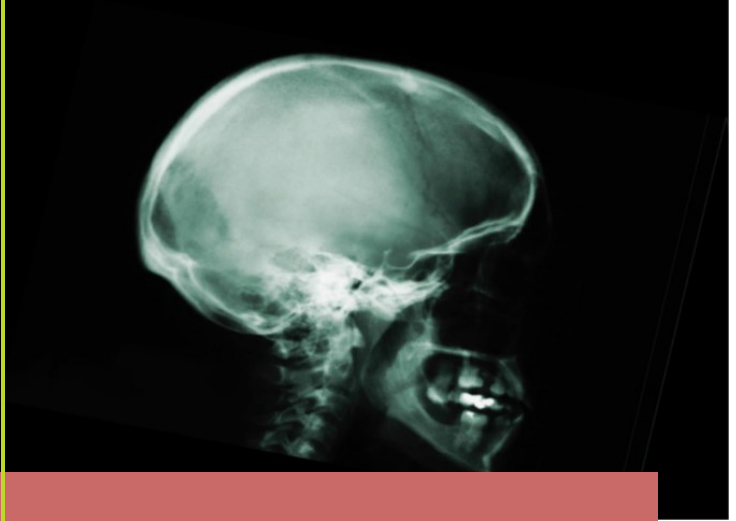
# SIGN UP FOR SCRUBS CAMP!

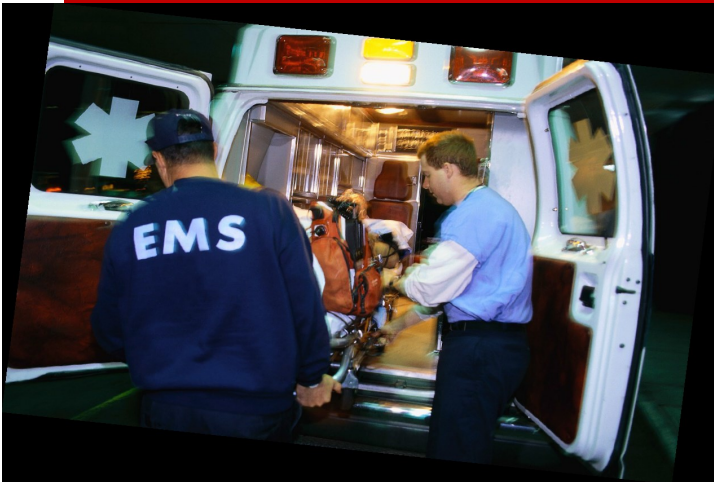

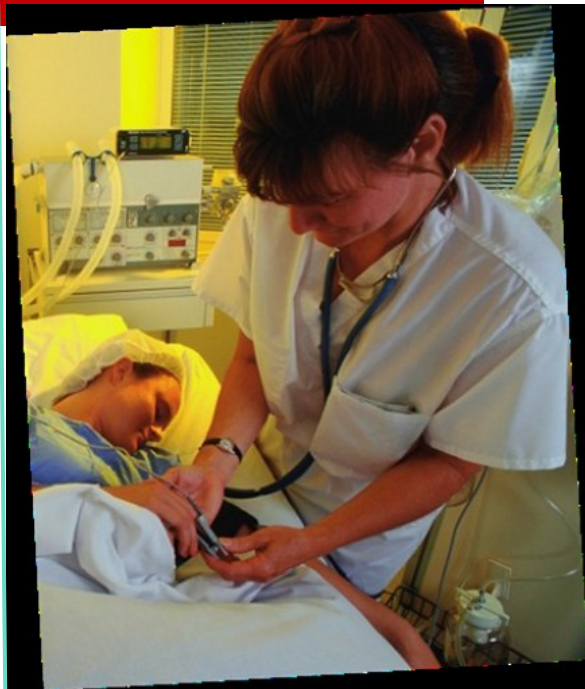
