Professions: A variety of health professions **Grade Level**: 6-12

All HOTT lesson plans are designed with the purpose of increasing students' awareness of the variety of health careers that are available to them. If possible, invite the corresponding health professional into your classroom to discuss his/her occupation. If this is not an option, use the attached sheet(s) to share this/these career(s) with your students.

Purpose: To introduce students to different health professions.

Materials needed: Computer with PowerPoint, <u>HOTT Jeopardy PowerPoint Game</u>, and scoreboard worksheet (attached). Save game to hard drive and enable macros.

Duration: 15 minutes

Instructions:

- Split the class into 3 groups. This game works like the television show Jeopardy.
- The first group picks a category and value.
- Click on the value chosen under the correct category. After they answer click on the screen to get the correct answer.
- The teams must answer in question form. (E.g. what is doctor?) Answers do not need to be exact!
- After the answer appears, click on "scores" in the lower right hand corner. Cross out squares on the worksheet after they have been used.
- If the team gets the question right, add the value to their money on slide 3 but if they get it wrong subtract it from their money value.
- After adding or subtracting the amount click on the round you are on in the upper left hand corner.
- The next group now gets a turn.
