## **Healthcare Scavenger Hunt**



Professions: Genetic Counselor

Grade Level: 3-9

All HOTT lesson plans are designed with the purpose of increasing students' awareness of the variety of health careers that are available to them. If possible, invite the corresponding health professional into your classroom to discuss his/her occupation. If this is not an option, use the attached sheet(s) to share this/these career(s) with your students.

**Purpose**: Students will use computer skills to uncover the answers to the healthcare scavenger hunt. In the process they will learn about the many Healthcare professions.

Materials needed: Scavenger Hunt Question Sheet, computer with internet access, writing utensil

**Duration**: 1 class period

#### Instructions:

- The teacher should hand out the question sheets to the students; each student should be assigned one profession (students may do more than one if time permits).
- Professions may be assigned by the teacher, drawn from a hat, or chosen by the student.
- Students can access the US Department of Labor website or any other sites with information

- Answer all of the questions on the question sheet. Students must use at least three different web sources and site each source.

After completing the questions the student should write a brief paragraph stating his or her opinion on the profession: Does the profession seem interesting? Did you know about it before conducting the research? Would you consider going into this career in the future?
